In this article I will explain how you can get the tourist visa to China in the UK, in a simple and economical way, collecting all the documents electronically from your computer. Chinese visa it can be done in two ways: using the online visa service offered by China Visa Direct or through the Chinese Visa Application Service Center (CVASC) in London, Manchester, Edinburgh and Belfast.Important notes:I will try to keep this article up to date, but keep in mind that proceedings in consulates sometimes change overnight, so I recommend comparing the information in this article to the official information provided by Chinese consulates in the UK.This article focuses on obtaining chinese visa in the UK, even if the process is the same in the US , Canada, Australia or eu countries. However, the process may differ slightly in each country, so it is better to consult the Websites of the Chinese consulate in each country. INTRODUCTION Until recently, the Chinese visa process in the UK was carried out at the consulates of the Chinese Embassy in the UK; however, due to the increased demand for visas, the Chinese Consulate has delegated these functions to a private agency, the Chinese Visa Application Service Center (CVASC). If you only had to pay consular fees (£85 for the single entry tourist visa), you now have to add the service charges charged by this private agency (£85), so that the total cost of the single entry visa is £151, as long as you do the process yourself at one of their offices in London, Manchester, Edinburgh and Belfast. If you live away from one of these cities and apply via the courier service, the tourist visa fee is higher (£175). In addition, since 2016 it is also possible to carry out the Chinese visa process online and without moving from home, through the renowned collective or group visa. This process is performed by a private agency in Shanghai, called China Visa Direct, and the visa is issued to groups of 2 or more people traveling together and with the same itinerary to China. The cost is €129 (GBP 115). If in the visa process in the Chinese Visa Application Service Center (CVASC) you have to physically send a series of documents and get the visa physically locked in the passport at the end of the process, in the case of the collective online visa you have to send the scanned documents through an online form and what you get at the end is a sheet with the stamped visa, containing a list of the names of the group traveling to China; this sheet is not attached to your passport and is sent from Shanghai to your home via international courier, such as FEDEX, UPS or DHL. In this article, I will explain step by step how to apply for a tourist visa to China in two ways: online via China Visa Direct (section 1) or through the Chinese Visa Application Service Center (section 2).1. GETTING YOUR CHINESE VISA ONLINE: China Visa DirectThe easiest and fastest way to get a visa for China is through China Visa Direct, a Shanghai-based travel agency, in particular, in the renowned Shanghai Free Trade Zone, a created by the Chinese government to promote innovation, development and business growth. The name of the agency behind China Visa Direct is Shanghai Orange & amp; Orange Travel Agency.During 2016, it launched the first online platform specializing in applying for collective visas for China, through which it is possible to apply for the Chinese collective visa for groups of 2 to 10 people, without leaving the house. You won't have to go to any consulate. The visa is issued by the Immigration Office of the Shanghai Ministry of Public Security and to obtain it some requirements must be met. Previous questions about online visaWhat requirements should be met? The online collective tourist visa is a visa issued for groups of at least 2 people and a maximum of 10. All members of the group must make the same itinerary in China, entering and leaving the country at the same time. It is an ideal visa if you travel with family or friends and everyone will do the same itinerary. To obtain this visa you need to scan the documents and send them electronically: a copy of the passport page with your personal information, a copy of the return ticket (by plane or train) and a copy of the hotel reservations. After sending the documents online and making the payment, they will send the visa to your home address, by international courier. The visa is an A4-sized sheet, detailing the information of the authorized group. The price may vary, depending on your nationality. Prices are in euros. For British it costs €129 per person (GBP 115), although if you use the code #CH17122110BLGRSL# (with numerical signs included) you will have a 10% discount, so the total price per person would be €116.10 (about £104). You can find the list of countries that can process this visa and prices, based on nationality, here at this link: . The visa is valid for citizens of the United States, United Kingdom, Australia, New Zealand, South Korea and European countries. When can I start the proceedings? You can start applying for a visa online about 20 days in advance. It doesn't matter if you start applying multiple days in advance, as this agency will still start the process 15 days before you arrive in China.Why do they do that? Because it is a visa valid for 30 days from the date of entry into China, which must be used within 15 days from the date of issue. The visa is valid for a single entry, so if you plan to leave China to re-enter (two entrances), this visa won't work for you. Since you are sending the documentation, the visa takes about 3 working days, to which you must add another 3 working days when it takes the visa to get to your home, via FEDEX, UPS or DHL international courier service. Example: If you request the July 16, 2019 (Tuesday), as the scheduled date for entry into China is August 1, 2019, you will receive the visa at your home around July 24, 2019 2019 If the visa issue date is July 20, 2019 (approximately), this would mean that you must enter China before August 3, 2019 (within 15 days of the visa issue date). If you enter China on August 1, the validity of the visa will be until August 30 (30 days from the date of entry into China). Here you can see a true example of a group visa:It is a visa issued on June 4, 2019 and that must be used to enter China no later than June 18, 2019 (no problem if you enter on June 18 or before June 18, but you can't enter from June 19). If you enter China, for example, on June 15, you can stay in China until July 14, as the visa is valid for up to 30 days. If you enter on June 18, you can stay until July 17. The visa is valid for a single entry. Next, I will explain the steps to apply and process the collective online visa: Phase 1. Sign up on the platformBefore you start the process of applying for a collective visa, you need to register on the platform. After filling out the registration form, you will be sent an email with platform login data (if it doesn't arrive, check your email's spam folder). RELATED How to apply for an electronic visa to Uzbekistan (electronic visa)If the group leader or head of the family signs, it is sufficient and can be responsible for the request for all members of the group, as well as managing the total payment. Step 2. Select the visa typeSelect the visa type, in this case, group visa:Step 3. Enter your personal information and submit documentation onlineIn this step, you'll need to enter your personal information and attach each member of the group's travel documentation. It is very important to carefully review and check personal information, as the visa issued will be based on this data. There is a field where you can specify a different shipping address, if different from your home address. As for the documents, it is the same that you request from the consulate, only in this case you have to send electronically: the passport page containing your personal information, airline (or train) tickets and all hotel reservations for the duration of the trip. You can send only one file for each document, so if, for example, you have several hotel reservations in separate files, bring them together in one file. In this step, you must enter the #CH17122110BLGRSL# code (with numeric marks included) to get a 10% discount for all members of the group, and then click Apply. IMPORTANT UPDATE. Since September 2018, the Ministry of Public Security has also requested to provide a recent photo to Color (size: 48 mm x 33 mm). Instructions on this link. Therefore, when applying for a group visa, you must also send a photo of each of the group. You can attach the photo within the Accommodation Booking section. If you need to add new travelers, you have the Add a person button below. You must also accept the terms of use, and then click the Submit button. In the following example I have two Australian travelers, whose total cost, with the 10% discount included, is 160.20 euros (80.10 euros x 2 people). For British citizens the cost would be € 232.2 (116.10 x 2 people). After that, you should carefully check that all the information is correct, and if so, click the Confirm button. It is very important to review and carefully verify the information before clicking the Confirm button, since once confirmed, you will not be able to edit it. If you need to make a change, you must press the Edit button. Step 4. Making the paymentThe last part of the process is to make the payment. You can do this PayPal with your credit/debit card or bank transfer. To speed up the process, it is preferable to choose payment PayPal or by card. If you choose a card, you must choose between Visa or MasterCard and enter your information:Payment includes visa fees, agency management fees and shipping costs for sending the visa by international courier, via FEDEX, UPS or DHL. After the payment is completed you will receive an email confirmation and you will be able to track the visa on your website. Step 5. Receiving the visaThe collective visa will arrive at the parent company's home address, i.e. the person who was responsible for all the management of the process (unless during the application process indicated another different address where it is more convenient to receive the visa). This is an example of what the visa looks like: the visa will be required upon your entry into China. If you see that the customs official goes looking for the visa in your passport, you can tell him that this is a group visa and that it is provided on a separate sheet. Upon exiting the country, customs will keep the visa. Therefore, there will be no trace of your passage through China in your passport.2. CHINESE VISA PROCEEDS IN THE CHINESE VISA APPLICATION SERVICE CENTER (CVASC)British citizens normally need a visa to enter mainland China, including Hainan Island, but not in Hong Kong or Macau. If you are transiting china, visa waiver is available in certain places. There are many types of visa, depending on the purpose of the trip: tourist visa, business visa, transit visa, study visa, work visa, etc. Next, I will explain step by step how to process the tourist visa for China in the UK. Preliminary considerations to understand the Chinese visa processBefore you start explaining in detail each of the steps to follow to apply for a tourist visa to China in the UK, it is convenient to answer some basic questions to better understand the application process. When is the right time to start the procedure? It is advisable to start the process of requesting the between 30 and 45 days before the date of entry into China. You can apply for a visa up to 3 months in advance, but it is not advisable to do so quickly, as I will explain later, the validity of the visa begins to count since the consulate issues the will I receive my visa? If you complete the process in person and correctly send all the required documentation, you will have the visa in about 5 working days. However, keep in mind that the number of processing days may vary, depending on the time of year and existing demand, but on average it is about 5 business days. This period can be shortened if you use the Express or Urgent procedure, paying more. Example: If you send documents on Wednesdays, your visa will likely be ready on the Wednesday of the following week. If you perform the remote process through the CVASC courier service, the processing time is 10 working days. Example: If you send documents by courier on Wednesdays, you'll receive your passport with your visa at your home in about two calendar weeks (maybe less, depending on your place of residence). What is the validity period of the visa? The period of validity of the visa refers to the period between the date of issue of the visa (when sending the application) and the expiry date of the visa. This is the period during which it is possible to enter China. It can be 3 months, 6 months or 1 year. As I explain later, this does not mean that you can stay 3, 6 or 12 months in China.Example: if you plan to enter China on August 1, 2018 and send the correct documentation in person to the CVASC on July 1, 2018, your visa should be issued and ready by July 7, 2018 (add another 7 days if you are doing the process by courier). The visa would be valid for 3 months from the date of issue, approximately, from 1 July 2018 to 1 October 2018 (3 months). What is the maximum length of stay? The length of stay refers to the period in which you can stay in China since you entered the country. With a tourist visa (an entry visa) with a validity period of 3 months, the maximum period of stay is 30 days. Example: If your visa is valid from July 1, 2018 to October 1, 2018 and you enter China on August 1, 2018, you can stay in China for up to 30 days, which means until August 30. If you enter China on September 11, and the validity period ends on October 1, you can only stay in China for 20 days. Both the period of validity of the visa and the duration of the stay are indicated in the visa. Below is an example of what a 3-month tourist visa (an entry visa) and a 30-day stay duration look like:The information shown in the visa is as follows:Visa category: L (tourism)Validity: 3 months, from October 6, 2015 to January 6, 2016.Issue date: October 6, 2015Birthdate visa holder nameNumber of registrations allowed : 01 (in the next section, I explain what it means)Length of stay : 30 days after enteringStitute issuePassport What does the number of entries refer to? An important concept is the number of which refers to the times at which you can enter China during the visa validity period. Therefore, the visa can be: Single entry. The most common is the single entry visa, through which you can enter China only once. It doesn't matter if you enter China through Beijing and leave through another city like Shanghai, as in this case I would only enter China once. The single-entry tourist visa is valid for 3 months (just like the previous image). Double entrance. It means you can enter China twice. For example, if you enter China and stay in the country for a few days and then want to visit another country (for example, Laos, Vietnam, Mongolia, Nepal, India or Japan), the double entry visa will allow you to return to China during the visa period. The double entry visa is valid from 3 to 6 months from the date of issue. Below is an example of a double entry business visa (the single tourist entry visa would be the same, but would indicate L instead of M). Note that the length of stay is 6 months (October 6, 2015 to April 6, 2016) and that the duration of each stay (every time you enter China) is 30 days, which means you can stay for 30 days every time you enter China (in total, you can stay a maximum of 60 days in China, 30 days for each time you enter). RELATED How to get an electronic visa to India online: Important step-by-step guide: The visa gives you the right to enter mainland China, which refers to the area of China under the effective sovereignty of the People's Republic of China, but does not include the special administrative regions of Hong Kong and Macau (former European colonies). This means that if you want to visit Hong Kong (or Macau) during your trip to China and return to China, you will need a double entry visa. More voices. The multiple entry visa is the one that allows you to enter China as many times as you want during the visa validity period. It is valid from 6 months to 1 year (or even longer). As you can see in the screenshot below, in the Voices section, M is indicated (which means multiple entries). For every time you enter China during the visa validity period, you can be there for 30 days. Now that all these concepts have been clarified, I will explain to you step by step how to process the tourist visa for China in the UK. Step 1. Having a Passport To obtain a Chinese visa, the first thing you will need is a passport that meets the following conditions:It must be valid for a minimum of 6 months from the day you apply for a visa. For example, if you apply for a visa on July 1, 2018, your passport must have a valid date beyond January 1 2019.If your passport must have at least one blank page, to enter the visa there. Your passport must not show any kind of deterioration, such as being ripped off the cover, being stained or having broken pages. In these cases it is better to renew your passport before applying for a visa, since in the consulate they are very strict and will not approve the visa if the passport is damaged. Other things to keep in mind about your passport are: To apply for a visa you need to (or send by courier) the original passport, which will remain in the hands of the consulate for a few days. This is because the visa will be attached to one of the passport pages. In addition to the original passport, you must also send a photocopy of the passport page indicating personal information, photo and signature. Step 2. Buy tickets for the plane, train or other means of transportAccording to process the visa it is mandatory to present a copy of the round-trip tickets of the means of transport that you will use to enter and leave China, be it an airplane, train or bus. If you travel to China by plane, the best prices are usually about three months before booking your trip. Some airlines, such as British Airways, China Eastern Airlines, Air China, Hainan Airlines or Virgin Atlantic, offer non-stop direct flights from the UK to China, but there are many other airlines with which you can fly at airports. Once you have purchased your ticket, you must print it:If you enter or leave by train from China, you must also send a copy of the train tickets. However, there is no need to present tickets for the trips you will make in the countryside (for example, if you plan to travel by train from Beijing to Shanghai, there is no need to present your train ticket). Some tips:Check your airline's refund policy - if you're not sure about your visa application it might be wise to pay a small extra for a refundable ticket. Additionally, some insurers may offer a canceled benefit for the denied visa, but you'll have to pay more for this type of coverage. Step 3. Make hotel reservationsSi chinese authorities want to know where you will be at all times and what your itinerary will be. For this reason, in addition to air or rail tickets, they will also require documentation justifying the itinerary you are about to make (and that, as I will show you later, you must indicate in the application form). If you travel alone and stay at the hotel... The most common case is when you travel independently and stay at the hotel. In this case, all hotel reservations must be submitted and must cover the entire duration of the trip. The most practical thing is to make all hotel reservations through the Booking platform, in those accommodations that allow free cancellation. This way, once you get a visa, you can change the hotel reservations for others; in case your travel plans change or find another hotel that best suits your needs. On the following screen shot, you can see an example of a confirmed booking with free cancellation. It is enough that the name of the person making the reservation appears (this name, if necessary, can also be changed from booking's personal area):If you travel with an agency... If going to China with a travel agency with an organized tour, they can issue an invitation letter that should contain your information, the you will have, hotels where you will stay and the information of the agency that invites you. If you are visiting Chinese friends or foreigners residing in China... In this case, you must ask your friend to write you an invitation letter with your information, information about the visit (days of arrival and departure, places to visit, relationship between the applicant and the person inviting), as well as their personal information (name, phone, address in China and signature). Step 4. Fill out the application formThis time you have the previous documentation (passport, tickets and hotel reservations), you can fill out the application form. You have to do it electronically. Handwritten forms are no longer accepted. As for the electronic form, you should consider that:After completing electronically, you need to print it. Each person with a passport must fill out a different form. If you have minor children, you must fill out the form and sign it for them (both the father and the mother). Applicants under the age of 18 must provide the birth certificate with the names of the parents (original and copy) and the passports of both parents (original page and copy of the information and signature page)If after printing it, you need to correct one section and you cannot retrieve the previous form, you will have to fill out a new form and reprint it (there is no problem filling out a new form, even if you have already filled out another one before). Let's see how to fill out form:1. Go to the CVASC website. You will see that you can choose between the centers of London, Manchester and Edinburgh-Belfast.In this example, I will access the CVASC center in London. Then you need to click Download, and then click Chinese Visa Application Form. You can click here to download an empty application form and fill out electronically with a computer. Remember to print the completed application form once finished and sign, if necessary.2. Once downloaded, you can fill out the form. Recommendations:Part 1. Personal Information In the Middle Name field, you can leave it blank if not applicable. In answers to some of the questions, you can list them as Not Applicable or N/A (for example, if you didn't have a previous nationality). In section 1.11 it is necessary to indicate the passport number (it can be found on the first page). It is very important to correctly specify your mobile number and email, as if there was a problem in your application or if a document is missing, they will contact you. You must specify passport details, such as: date of issue, expiration date, and place of issue. Current data on work and education. Specify the main members of your family: Enough to enter the names of parents, spouse, and children. The information of a person to contact, in case of emergency. Longest stay in China: Since I planned my trip for 10 days (August 1 to August 10, 2018), I specified 10 days, but you can indicate up to 30 days, as the maximum duration of each stay is 30 days (as I explained earlier). China Itinerary: Take the hotel reservations you made and indicate the city, the day you arrive at each hotel, and your address (the easiest way is to enter Booking.com and copy and paste hotel addresses into the form). If your travel expenses are covered by you, select Me. If you're filling out the form for your children, select Parents or Legal Guardians. Inviting Party Information in China: In case you are invited by a friend or relative residing in China.Specifies whether you have previously obtained another Chinese visa and its information. Point out other countries you've visited in the last 12 months. Do not forget to introduce, at least, those that are reflected in the passport. Part 3: The Committee on Other Information. You need to answer some simple questions, and if there are companions using the same passport as the applicant, you must also provide their information. Part 4: The Committee on Declaration and Signature. You have the option to include the representative's information. If you fill out the form of your spouse or relatives, you don't have to fill out the representative details, you just need to print the form and give it to your family member to sign and date it. Once the form is printed, there are still three things to do: paste a photo, sign it, and date it. Photography. In the consulate, they are quite strict with photos. It is always preferable to do it without glasses and with a white background. The size must be 48 x 33 millimeters. In this screenshot, you have the official instructions of the consulate on the requirements that the photo must meet:IMPORTANT: the photo must be glued to the form, not stapled. Signature and date on the form. Finally, you need to sign the form and enter the date of the day you complete it or the day you send the documentation. Step 5. Sign Document Terms and ConditionsYou must download and sign the Terms and Conditions document. Each application must attach a Terms and Conditions document. Step 6. Submit documentation (and make payment)Now that you have all the documentation ready (form filled out with photo and signature, round-trip tickets, hotel reservations, terms and conditions documents, and a photocopy of the passport page indicating your personal information and photo), it is time to send all documents to the The process of sending documents can be done in person or by courier. Important. As of May 8, 2018, the Visa Centre will purchase the fingerprints of some applicants on behalf of the Chinese Embassy and consulted in accordance with Chinese laws and regulations. Meanwhile, the consular officer can also request an interview with some applicants and collect their then pringerprints according to Chinese laws and regulations. Step 6.1. Face-to-face proceduereIt is mandatory to make the appointment in advance and submit your application to the Visa Center during the period of time you have appointed online. The dispatch peak hours are between 10:00 .m. and 13:00.m. (try to avoid this period if possible). The Visa Centre allows for a number of appointments in each 30-minute time slot. Upon arrival, show a printout of the appointment information and you'll be given a queue number based on the first time you arrive at the first serve. You can check the detailed rates here: Step 6.2. Proceeding by courierIn CVASC you have a checklist if you plan to send the document by courier, which you must fill in and sign. As you can see in this checklist, when shipping is made by courier you need to provide new documentation:First, you need to fill out the payment authorization form, with your card details, where you will be charged the total cost. Personally I think it is a very dangerous system, since if this letter gets lost, other people may know your personal information and make fraudulent purchases. Secondly, you must attach an envelope already paid for returning passports with a visa to your address in the shipment (otherwise the CVASC will include the envelope and charge you for it). Once you have all the documentation listed in the checklist, put it in an envelope and send it. In the same checklist center you have the shipping address. You can apply for several visas in a single shipment. Step 7. Check your passport with your visaPopo have received your passport with your visa, you need to verify that all the information is correct: validity period, number of entries, length of stay and personal information. If you find an error or omission, let CVASC know so that they correct it. If is attributable to you, additional fees will apply, otherwise they will correct it immediately at no additional cost.3. POST-VISA PROCESS: Immigration card and registrationWhen you arrive in China, you still have to do a couple of proceedings: the immigration card arriving in China and registration. Upon exiting the country, you must hand over your departure card.3.1. The immigration card arriving in China (and departing from China)Upon arrival in China you must fill in the Arrival Card, which will be kept by the immigration manager. You will keep the Departure Card, which you will have to deliver when you leave the country. Here is an example of this immigration card (front and back):It is very simple to fill. On the arrival card you must indicate:Name of the familyNationalityPassport NoIntended Address in ChinaMale / FemaleDate of birthVisa NoPlace of Visa IssuanceFlight No/Ship's name/Train NoPurpose of visit (only one): for sight tourismseeing/in leisureSignatureThe departure card is just as simple to fill:Family nameNodata family nameNoData births / Female flight name / Ship name / NoSignature train If you lose this card, nothing will happen, how can you get a new card at the airport to fill out, since it does not come with stamps or special numbers.3.2. Foreign registration in China On the back of the immigration card, you will see an important announcement; section 1 warns that foreigners who do not stay at hotels, hostels or guesthouses must register their arrival (alone or from the host of the house) within 24 hours (72 hours in rural areas) at the nearest police station, where they will give you a form that you need to fill out and will ask for your passport and copies of the page where your personal information comes from, as well as the visa and entrance stamp. If you stay at the hotel there are no problems, as at check-in, the hotel will take care of the registration.
